## **ROMANS 9:4-5** God's Great Plan & Purpose for Israel -Unalterable!



#### *Romans 9:1-3*

- God is NOT done with the nation Israel.
- Paul is not simply praying for the individual salvation of Jews.
- He is praying for the national salvation of Israel.



### **Three Necessary Clarifications**

REVIEW

- 1 No one ever receives salvation apart from personal faith in Jesus Christ which results in a righteous standing before God.
- 2 Paul's use of the word salvation vs righteousness



#### What do we mean by "national salvation" for Israel? The promised Kingdom is national salvation for Israel!



#### The Church's Misinterpretation of the "Kingdom of God"

REVIEW

The Church, by and large, has made a deadly departure from Paul's doctrine of our <u>heavenly position</u>, and made the Church a political and social <u>kingdom on earth</u>.



#### ...who are Israelites...

- Paul defines his "kinsmen" very clearly here as "Israelites".
- Paul is about to tell us the things that belong to these "kinsmen".
- Physical birth into the family of Israel is required to be an Israelite!

<ul> <li>earthly, visible display of God's shekinah glory.</li> <li>not present on the earth today</li> <li>will return to the future millennial temple (Ezek 43)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>to glory</li> <li>invisible to fleshly eyes. #### "The giving of the Law"

- Mosaic law was given
  exclusively to Israel (Deut 4:8)
- the law is essentially the "terms" of the Mosaic
  Covenant (Ex 19:56) "if/then"
- blessing for obedience, cursing for disobedience
  the New Covenant will enable perfect obedience to the Law in the Kingdom (Jer 31:33; Ezek 36:27)

- The Church is made up of those who have "died to the law".
- The Church is under NO law code
- we operate under a grace principle (pure unmerited blessing)

"The temple service"	
<ul> <li>given a tabernacle/temple and specific blood sacrifices as a way of access to God (a way of approach)</li> <li>a unique privilege among all the nations</li> <li>But they could only come so close (limited)</li> <li>And even then, they were only coming to a "shadow of the real thing" (Heb 8:5; 10:1)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>direct access into the Holy of Holies God's presence in Heaven by means of the blood of Christ.</li> <li>(Heb 9:11; 10:19)</li> <li>this is the real thing!</li> </ul>



Israel	The Church
"The promises"	
<ul> <li>the Old Testament is full of promised blessings to the nation Israel on the earth.</li> <li>all of God's promises for Israel are related to the covenants made with them</li> <li>a promise implies future fulfillment not yet realized</li> <li>God stakes His character on the fulfillment of His promises to Israel.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>there are no covenant promises to the Church</li> <li>all of our blessings are heavenly</li> <li>we already possess all of our blessings in Christ Jesus</li> <li>the promises to Israel are NOT fulfilled in the Church!</li> </ul>

<i>"Whose are the fathers"</i>	
- the offer of these unique privileges is to all who have physical descent from Abraham, Isaac, and	<ul> <li>physical descent has nothing to do with being in the Church</li> </ul>
Jacob (physical birth) - receiving the fulfillment of these things requires positional righteousness (spiritual birth) (verses 6 and 7)	Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.



# ...and from whom is the Christ according to the flesh, who is over all, God blessed forever. Amen.

- Jesus, in His humanity, is a physical descendant of Abram, Isaac and Jacob.
- Jesus Christ *is* the one who is over all. He is God who is forever blessed.

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VERSE

 Israel's only hope of salvation rests on Jesus Christ. His deity and His humanity.
