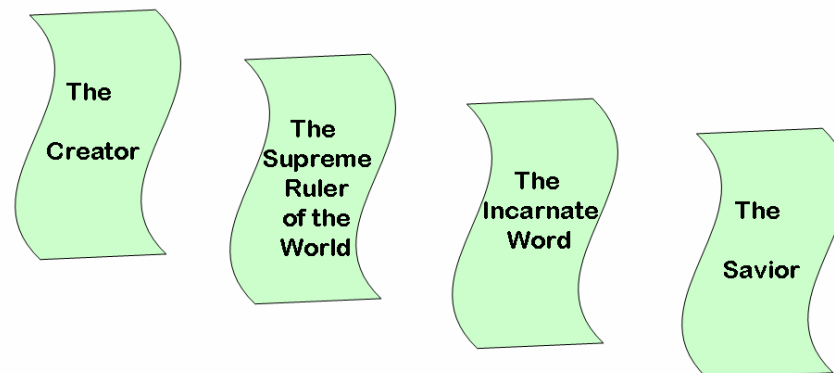

- Colossians 1:16 - all things -
 - created by Him
 - for Him
 - in Him they hold together

• were made (KJV)
• come into a new state of being (ginomai)

- Eph1:20-22 - seated Him(Christ) at the right hand in heavenly places
 - Far above every government
 - Far above every authority
 - Far above every power
 - Far above every dominion

• Jesus Christ as the Incarnate Word

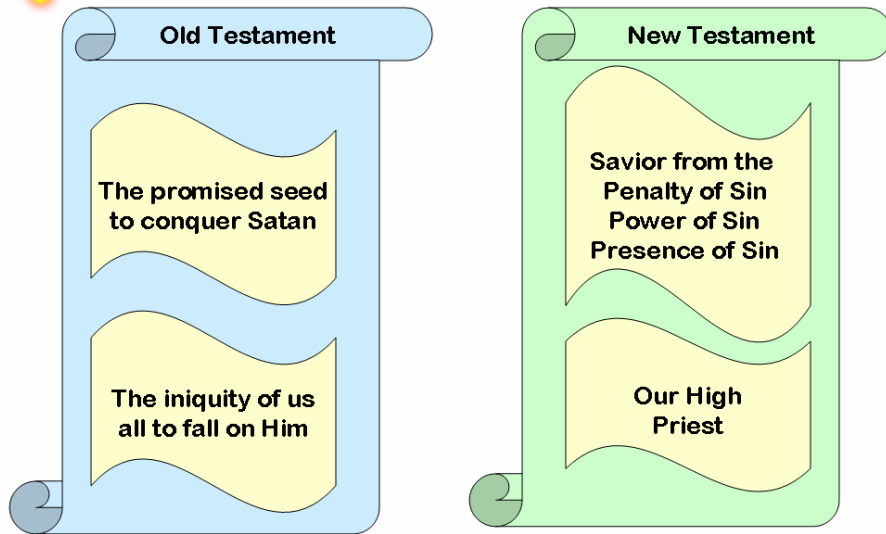
- John 1:1
