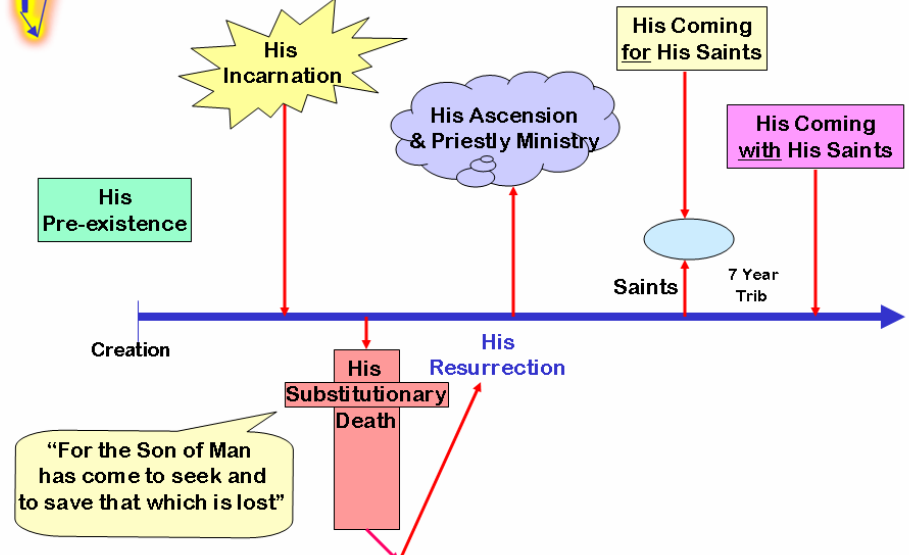

The death of Christ

Assures us of the Love of God toward the sinner

A Redemption or Ransom to a Holy God for the sinner

The Substitute bearing the penalty of the sinner

MAJOR BIBLE THEMES

God the Son: His Substitutionary Death

The assurance of God's Love toward the sinner

- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son
- Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us
- 1 John 3:16 We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us
- 1 John 4:9 By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son

The Redemption/Ransom to a Holy God for sinners

Greek	English	Definition	Verses
agorazo	bought, purchased	to buy in the market place	1 Cor 6:20, 1 Cor 7:23, 2 Peter 2:1
exagorazo	redeemed, delivered	to buy out of the market place	Gal 3:13, Gal 4:4,5
lutroo	redeem, redeemed	to let loose or set free	Titus 2:14, 1 Pet 1:18-20
apolutrois	redemption	a releasing for a ransom upon payment	Eph 1:7, Col 1:14, Heb 9:15



MAJOR BIBLE THEMES

God the Son: His Substitutionary Death

The Judgment or Condemnation of the Sin Nature



Fruit = personal sins
1 Cor. 15:3 --- Christ died for our sins

- Sins which are personal failures or transgressions
- vs.
- Sin which is a nature

Root = Sin (Sin Nature)
Rom. 6:10 --- He died unto sin



MAJOR BIBLE THEMES

God the Son: His Substitutionary Death

The Substitute bearing the penalty of the sinner

- John 10:11
 - the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep
- Romans 5:6 & 8
 - For while we were still helpless
 - Christ died for the ungodly
 - God demonstrates His own love toward us
 - while we were yet sinners
 - Christ died for us
- 1 Pete 3:18
 - For Christ also died for sins once for all,
 - the just for the unjust,
 - in order that He might bring us to God
