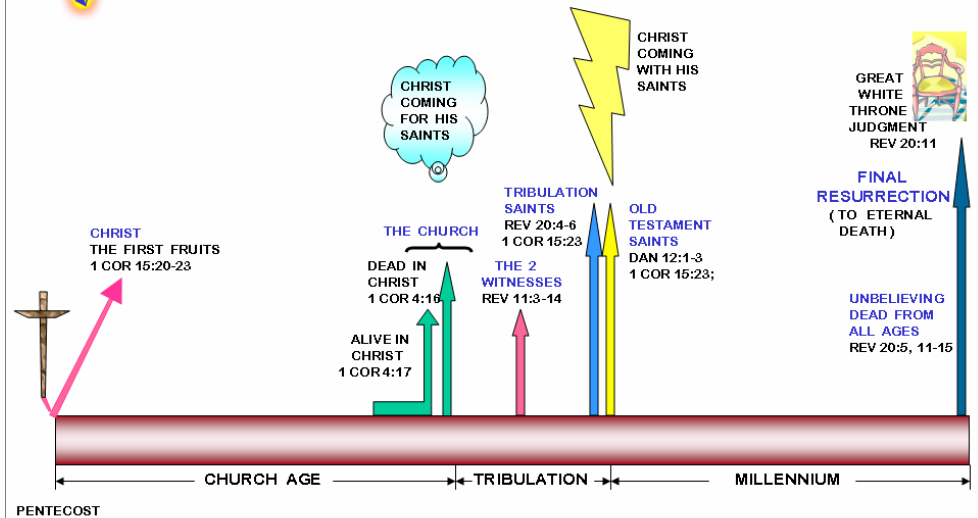

Christ's rule during the Millennium

- **Christ will rule the entire earth**
 - --- and all the nations will stream to it (mountain of the house of the Lord) Isa. 2:2
 - Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Your inheritance, and the very ends of the earth as Your possession PS. 2:8
 - That all the peoples, nations and men of every language might serve Him Dan. 7:14
- **Christ will rule with absolute authority and power**
 - And let all kings bow down before him, all nations serve him PS. 72:11
 - --- He will rule them with a rod of iron Rev. 19:15
- **Christ will rule with righteousness and peace**
 - But with righteousness He will judge the poor Isa. 11:4-9
 - Also righteousness will be the belt about His loins
 - And the wolf will dwell with the lamb
 - And the leopard will lie down with the young goat
 - And the lion will eat straw like the ox.
 - The nursing child will play by the hole of the cobra

Mat. 5:5	For Zion's sake I will not keep silent, And for Jerusalem's sake I will not keep quiet, Until her righteousness goes forth like brightness, And her salvation like a torch that is burning. The nations will see your righteousness, Isa.62:1-2	He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. 2 Cor. 5:21
Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy. Mat. 5:6	Therefore hath the Lord recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eyesight. With the merciful thou wilt show thyself merciful; with an upright man thou wilt show thyself upright; PS 18:24	But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), Eph 2:4-5
Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God. Mat. 5:7	Who may ascend into the hill of the Lord? And who may stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart PS 24:3 Your eyes will see the King in His beauty; Isa 33:15	But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, namely, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned Heb. 2:9 and 2 Cor. 4:6
